Message from Alistair-

Pacific Palisades is one of Los Angeles most expensive and exclusive suburbs, home to film stars and billionaires. The broad boulevards are framed by palm trees and gated mansions with swimming pools. But as you may have seen on the news, it's in the grip of a raging firestorm that's ripping through community after community, raging and unremitting, threatening to destroy what many who live there consider to be their slice of paradise. One of the residents said this, 'This is surreal, this is unbelievable. I've lived here all my life but this is like nothing I've seen before.'

I was very struck by his words- 'This is like nothing I've seen before.' And the reason I was struck by his words was because I'd also just read them in the Bible- Mark 2:12.

While Jesus was preaching in a house four men arrived carrying a paralyzed man on a mat. They couldn't bring him to Jesus because of the crowd, so they dug a hole through the roof above his head. Then they lowered the man on his mat, right down in front of Jesus. Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the paralyzed man, "My child, your sins are forgiven." And then he heals him. And the man jumps up, grabs his mat, and walks out through the stunned onlookers.

And so Jesus demonstrates his divine authority- he has authority to forgive sins, and authority over sickness. And at the end of the account we read that the people were all amazed and praised God, exclaiming, "We've never seen anything like this before!" Mark 2:12.

Wouldn't it be wonderful if we could say the same thing this year- 'We have never seen anything like this before!' The sick healed, our loved ones coming to faith in Christ, our church growing spiritually and numerically, new opportunities for outreach and service, our own devotional lives deepening. The divine authority of Jesus means that all things are possible. And we too may be able to say, "We've never seen anything like this before!"
