Reflection

Grace and Truth by Hilary Forbes

"And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth" (John 1 verse 14).

We can imagine John, thinking back to the whole of Jesus' life, and trying to find a way of summing it all up. Out of his reed pen pours those words, and we glimpse his worship, love, and awe as he writes, empowered by the Holy Spirit.

While there is no account of the events leading up to the birth of Jesus in the Gospel of John, many of the words from John chapter 1 are frequently read out in carol services up and down the country. Those words, "the Word became flesh and dwelt among us" speak of a pivotal time in the history, not just of our world, but of the entire Cosmos. These are words which reflect and interpret the meaning of Jesus' birth, rather than the written record of Matthew's and Luke's accounts. It is impossible to think about the Word becoming flesh without immediately thinking of Jesus' entrance into the world.

We are now in the fourth week of Advent. As we approach Christmas Day itself, and the end of 2025, it is perhaps a good time to pause, and reflect on our own relationship with Jesus, the grace and truth He pours out on us, and how we can be grace and truth for one another and for those in our lives.

As we approach 2026, none of us knows what the year will hold, but we can walk into the New Year in the presence of the living God, with our friend and Saviour Jesus Christ, and in the love and fellowship of the Holy Spirit, with the assurance that gives us the confidence and certain hope to declare,

"You will show me the path of life; in your presence is fullness of joy" (Psalm 16 verse 11)
